Starting this project 2 lessons late I have a lot of catching up to do, firstly I've had a recap of the task and am ready to steam a head.

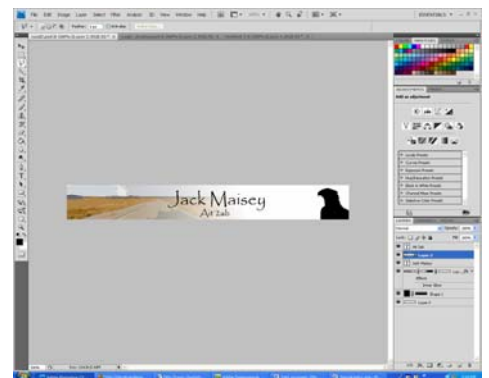
Firstly ill start with a plan of what I am to do first.

This lesson I have started trying new things with my banner it is hard to find the right eagle for my banner. I continued to work hard to make my own shadow.

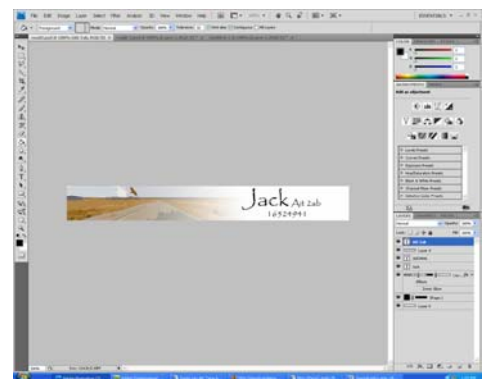


Journal entry three

11/8/09

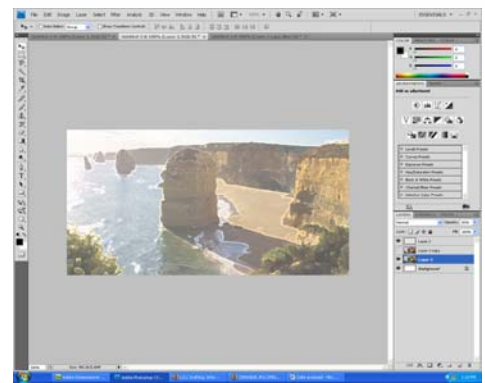
Today in AIT 2ab we have been modifying our websites and been finding out what our newly transformed websites look like so far. The hardest thing about today is the html on dream weaver.
